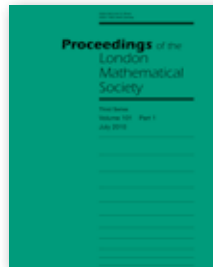


## The Computer Journal

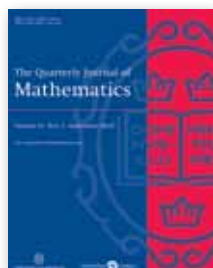


## IMA Journal of Numerical Analysis
