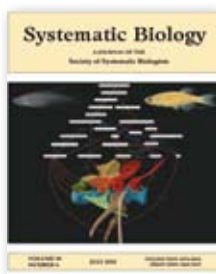

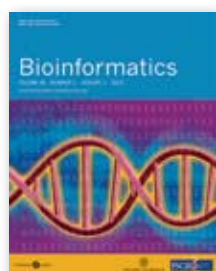


Systematic Biology

Publishing since 1953, 6 issues per year, and included in the 2009 ISI Journals Science Citation Index with an Impact Factor of 8.480.

Papers for this journal are original contributions to the theory, principles, and methods of systematics as well

as phylogeny, evolution, morphology, biogeography, paleontology, genetics, and the classification of all living things. A Points of View section offers a forum for discussion, while book reviews and announcements of general interest are also featured. Published on behalf of the Society of Systematic Biologists.



Bioinformatics

Publishing since 1985, 24 issues a year, and included in the 2009 ISI Journals Science Citation Index with an Impact Factor of 4.926.

The leading journal in its field, *Bioinformatics* publishes the highest quality scientific papers and review

articles of interest to academic and industrial researchers. Its main focus is on new developments in genome bioinformatics and computational biology. *Bioinformatics* also publishes online virtual issues, focusing on hot topics, such as next generation sequencing. An official journal of the International Society for Computational Biology.

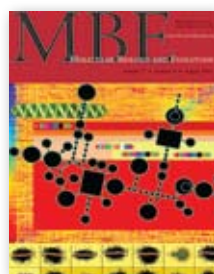


Environmental History

Publishing since 1996, 4 issues per year, and included in the 2009 ISI Journals Science Citation Index with an Impact Factor of 0.750.

This quarterly, interdisciplinary journal addresses issues relating to human interactions with the natural world

over time, and includes insights from history, geography, anthropology, the natural sciences, and many other disciplines. Published on behalf of American Society for Environmental History and the Forest History Society since 2010 (previously self-published).

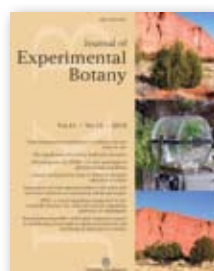


Molecular Biology and Evolution

Publishing since 1983, 12 issues per year, and included in the 2009 ISI Journals Science Citation Index with an Impact Factor of 9.872.

The journal publishes investigations of molecular evolutionary patterns and processes, tests of evolutionary hypotheses

that use molecular data, and studies that use molecular evolutionary information to address questions about biological function at all levels of organization. Published on behalf of the Society for Molecular Biology and Evolution.

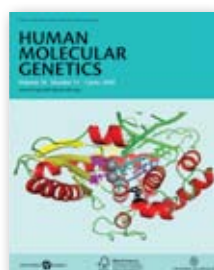


Journal of Experimental Botany

Publishing since 1949, 12 issues per year, and included in the 2009 ISI Journals Science Citation Index with an Impact Factor of 4.271.

The *Journal of Experimental Botany* (*JXB*) publishes high-quality primary research papers in the plant sciences,

as well as regular review collections, commissioned reviews, Darwin Reviews, and opinion articles. In addition to 12 regular issues, at least one Special Issue is published each year. Published on behalf of the Society for Experimental Biology.



Human Molecular Genetics

Publishing since 1992, 24 issues per year, and included in the 2009 ISI Journals Science Citation Index with an Impact Factor of 7.386.

Human Molecular Genetics publishes papers of excellence in all aspects of human molecular genetics. The journal includes a section dedicated to strongly

supported Association Studies, and publishes two highly popular Review issues each year.
