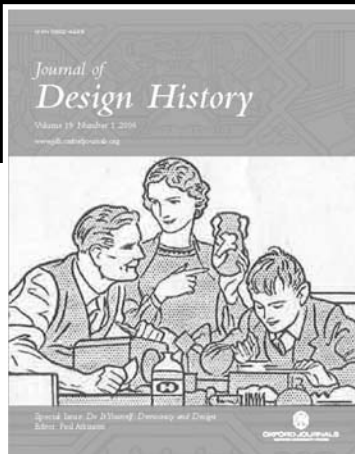


DO IT YOURSELF: *Democracy and Design*
